
Every year the Nevada Water Resources Association, an organization of water professionals throughout the state and the West, provides two \$1,000 scholarships to assist the serious student with degree completion.

Scholarships are awarded to students attending a Nevada university or community college. One scholarship is awarded to an undergraduate and one is awarded to a graduate student. Qualified students must be pursuing a degree in the field of water resources. Preference is given to students who have not yet received extensive monetary assistance, yet demonstrate scholastic aptitudes and serious long-term interest in the water resources industry. Serious junior or senior level undergraduate students and graduate students may apply or be recommended by college personnel. College freshmen, sophomore and high school students may apply if they wish, however, they are competing with upper classmen.

The 2015 application form must be received by December 1, 2014. Applications received after that date will not be considered. Students must submit the application form and a short (no more than one page) Curriculum Vita that emphasizes activities not included in the application form. A one paragraph description of their thesis topic, field of hydrologic interest or career goals in hydrology is required of all candidates. Applications must be received in electronic format. **Please note:** *The application materials required have changed — please read the flier carefully to make sure you complete your application appropriately. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.*

Upon receipt of scholarship funds, the recipient will read and provide their signature of an understanding that the awarded funds are to be used for educational purposes only. Educational purposes include payment for courses attended and books used for such courses.

Recipients are announced at the Annual NWRA Conference, an annual conference that brings water professionals together to discuss critical water issues facing Nevada and the West. The conference will be held January 27–29, 2015, at the Peppermill Resort Spa & Casino in Reno, NV. Winners will be contacted by phone prior to the conference.
